In honor of Jo's years of service, the Crowe & Dunlevy Foundation has committed to an annual gift of \$1,000 to fund the *Crowe & Dunlevy B. Jo Balding Scholarship for Students in the Legal Assistant Education Program at the University of Oklahoma Law Center.* Each year, the scholarship will assist one University of Oklahoma Law Center student enrolled in the Legal Assistant Education program in their pursuit of a career in the legal field and a legacy of their own.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

- 1. Applicants must be enrolled in the Legal Assistant Education program at the University of Oklahoma Law Center.
- 2. Applicants must be in academic good standing, with at least an 8.1 grade point average in legal specialty courses.
- 3. Applicants must have completed and received final grades for 3 credit hours in the Department of Legal Assistant Education at the time the application for the scholarship is submitted.
- 4. The sum of completed credits and credits the applicant is enrolled in for the Spring semester cannot be greater than 17 credit hours at the time the application for the scholarship is submitted.
- 5. Applicants must fully complete and submit the application, with all required documents attached, on or before the scholarship deadline.

How to Apply

Applicants must complete the following procedures to apply for the scholarship:

- 1. Applicants must submit a professional resume. Resumes typically include the applicant's contact information, educational history, employment history, extracurricular and/or community activities, memberships, honors, accomplishments and any leadership experience.
- 2. Applicants must fill out and submit the personal financial profile, which is used to determine financial need.
- 3. Applicants must submit a type-written essay. This 500 to 1,000 word, doublespaced essay should describe why the applicant is pursuing an education in the Legal Assistant Education program. The essay should also outline the applicant's career goals and desires.
- 4. Applicants must submit two letters of recommendation from an instructor, employer or community leader. Letters of recommendation should not come from family members of the applicant.

The letters of recommendation, which should be addressed to the Crowe & Dunlevy B. Jo Balding Scholarship Committee, typically outline the applicant's background, ambition, and leadership record, while explaining why the applicant should be awarded the scholarship.

5. Applicants must submit an official transcript of grades or an equivalent statement of academic good standing, which contains the most recent grade point average, for his/her most recent term in the Department of Legal Assistant Education.

The scholarship application deadline is May 1, 2023. Please forward the application materials to the address below.
