Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

1. Applicants must be enrolled in the Paralegal Studies program at the University of Oklahoma Law Center.
2. Applicants must be in academic good standing, with at least an 8.1 grade point average in legal specialty courses.
3. Applicants must have completed and received final grades for 3 credit hours in the Department of Paralegal Studies at the time the application for the scholarship is submitted.
4. The sum of completed credits and credits the applicant is enrolled in for the Spring semester cannot be greater than 17 credit hours at the time the application for the scholarship is submitted.
5. Applicants must fully complete and submit the application, with all required documents attached, on or before the scholarship deadline.

How to Apply

Applicants must complete the following procedures to apply for the scholarship:

1. Applicants must submit a professional resume. Resumes typically include the applicant's contact information, educational history, employment history, extracurricular and/or community activities, memberships, honors, accomplishments and any leadership experience.
2. Applicants must fill out and submit the personal financial profile, which is used to determine financial need.
3. Applicants must submit a type-written essay. This 500 to 1,000 word, double-spaced essay should describe why the applicant is pursuing an education in the Paralegal Studies program. The essay should also outline the applicant's career goals and desires.
4. Applicants must submit an official transcript of grades or an equivalent statement of academic good standing, which contains the most recent grade point average, for his/her most recent term in the Department of Paralegal Studies
