CONVOCATION SPEAKER

Judge Jodi W. Dishman
U.S. District Judge for the Western District of Oklahoma



Jodi W. Dishman was confirmed as United States District Judge for the Western District of Oklahoma on December 19, 2019, and received her commission on December 20, 2019. She earned her undergraduate degree from Southern Methodist University in 2002, where she served as Student Body President. She later graduated from the University of Oklahoma College of Law in 2005, where she served as Editor-in-Chief of the Oklahoma Law Review and earned several significant awards.

Following law school, Judge Dishman clerked for then-Chief Judge Carolyn Dineen King and Judge Edward C. Prado, both of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit. She also worked as an associate, later promoted to counsel, at Akin Gump Strauss Hauer & Feld, LLP in San Antonio, Texas, while her husband Judge Brent Dishman (also a graduate of OU Law School) served in the U.S. Air Force on active duty.

Judge Dishman returned home to Oklahoma in 2012, joining the law firm of McAfee & Taft. As a partner at McAfee & Taft, she handled high-stakes trial and appellate litigation in federal and state courts, with an emphasis on complex business litigation, insurance bad faith and coverage disputes, group benefits disputes, ERISA actions, and class actions.

Judge Dishman currently sits on the OU Law Board of Visitors, having previously served as the inaugural co-chair of the OU College of Law Young Alumni Board. She valued her time at OU Law because of the friendships, the professors, the learning environment, and the law school experience. She loved—and still cherishes—her time on the Oklahoma Law Review.

Judge Jodi Dishman is married to Brent Dishman, a district judge serving Oklahoma County, and has two sons, Cash (age 12) and Rook (age 11). We celebrate her family, and we celebrate her!
